All floats must be registered and in place by 5:45 to be judged. Floats will be judged according to theme, use of color, originality, design and general appearance.

Floats will receive a ribbon, award certificate and Chamber

Gift Bonds. First Place \$100, Second Place \$75 and Third Place \$50.
